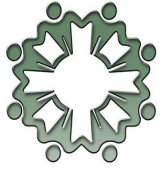
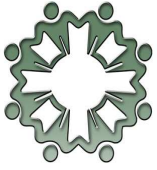

Scripture Reading: James 1:19-27

19 Understand this, my dear brothers and sisters: You must all be quick to listen, slow to speak, and slow to get angry. 20 Human anger does not produce the righteousness God desires. 21 So get rid of all the filth and evil in your lives, and humbly accept the word God has planted in your hearts, for it has the power to save your souls. 22 But don't just listen to God's word. You must do what it says. Otherwise, you are only fooling yourselves. 23 For if you listen to the word and don't obey, it is like glancing at your face in a mirror. 24 You see yourself, walk away, and forget what you look like. 25 But if you look carefully into the perfect law that sets you free, and if you do what it says and don't forget what you heard, then God will bless you for doing it. 26 If you claim to be religious but don't control your tongue, you are fooling yourself, and your religion is worthless. 27 Pure and genuine religion in the sight of God the Father means caring for orphans and widows in their distress and refusing to let the world corrupt you.

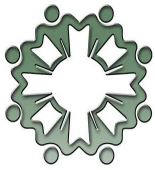
QUICK REVIEW: Looking back at this week's teaching on *James 1:19-27*, what was one thing that particularly caught your attention, challenged you, or confused you?

MY STORY

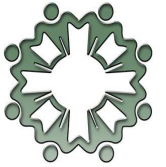
1. Do you do anything to observe *Lent*, the 40 day period between Ash Wednesday and Palm Sunday? It's not necessarily an Evangelical tradition, but is, for some, a good opportunity to get into the practicing of the spiritual discipline of fasting, and to emphasize God as your power and sustenance.
 - If you want something to do during this time, feel free to start the prayer guide *Seek God for the City* available at RVCC. This disciplined approach to prayer and evangelism is a great way to remind ourselves of what Jesus brought to this world in His salvation and the offer of freedom from sin available to all who believe in Him.

DIGGING DEEPER

1. When you read in James 1:22 from this week's message, "But prove yourselves doers of the word," what comes to your mind? What do you think is meant by the mandate to be a "doer of the word?"

2. Before you can put something into practice, you must first have an understanding of what that certain something is. This doesn't mean that every Christ-follower must be a seasoned theologian before he or she can live the way Christ calls His followers to live, but it is important to understand what the "word" is in order to do it. So, according to the following passage, what does the word say we are to do?
 - Matthew 22:36-40

3. If we were to stop right there, this thing we call Christianity would be solely motivated by meeting a list of requirements, and not about the relationship with have with the Living God of the universe. Our desire to grow closer to God should never be fulfilled by checking off a list of spiritual things to do, so why is there so much emphasis in the Bible on doing what God tells us? How does obedience to God's will deepen our relationship with Him? Use the following verses to answer this question:
 - Psalm 40:8-11
 - Matthew 12:50
 - Romans 6:15-18
 - Galatians 4:1-4
 - John 8:31-32

TAKING IT HOME

Thankfully, we serve a God who, in His perfection, perfectly loves, not by words but by action. Romans 5:8 tells us that "God **demonstrates** His own love towards us, that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us." Read 2 Corinthians 5:14-15. In what way can you commit this week to being a "doer of the word" thereby fulfilling Christ's desire that His sacrifice of love would compel His followers to serve His kingdom on earth? If you're having trouble thinking of a tangible way to begin this journey, start with the prayer guide *Seek God for the City* and be amazed at how effective the Holy Spirit is through your prayers for those around you.
